SPONSOR A SCHOOL

This is the perfect model for companies whose employees want to participate in making a difference in the community, but are short on time. Shoes That Fit does all the heavy lifting by identifying the school, getting kids measured, purchasing shoes and arranging an on-site delivery event at the school. Employees show up on delivery day to help distribute. \$5,000 helps 200 children, \$10,000 helps 400, \$20,00 helps 800.

Anytime co-workers can focus their collective attention on a project that is helping the community and promoting team building, it's a win-win.
